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ICM Omnibus background

This file contains the data collected as part of the ICM Omnibus survey. All the data and information is confidential and was collected in compliance with ISO 20252 and ISO 27001.

Methodology: ICM Omnibus is a quantitative syndicated survey conducted twice a week. The survey is conducted online, interviewing a nationally representative sample of 2,000 GB adults (aged 18+). Interviews are completed by members of ICM's newvista panel who have agreed to take part in our surveys. Participants are invited by email which are sent to panellists selected at random from our panel. Emails are sent to panellists selected at random from our panel. ICM always intends to complete all aspects of projects in house; however we reserve the right to outsource some elements using approved suppliers (e.g. our panel partners). The responding sample is weighted to the profile of the sample definition to provide a representative reporting sample. The nationally representative profile is based on census data collected by the Office for National Statistics.

All results are based on a sample and are therefore subject to statistical errors normally associated with sample-based information.
